









## Asylum Seekers and Refugees



## Offshore Detention:

- **Policy Overview:** Since August 2012, Australia has implemented a policy of offshore processing for individuals who arrive by boat seeking asylum. This policy involves transferring asylum seekers to detention centres located in Nauru and Manus Island, Papua New Guinea. [refugeecouncil.org.au](http://refugeecouncil.org.au)
- **Legal Framework:** In July 2013, the Australian Government established a policy stating that individuals arriving by boat seeking asylum would never be resettled in Australia, even if they are recognised as refugees. [refugeecouncil.org.au](http://refugeecouncil.org.au)
- **Human Rights Concerns:** Human rights organisations, including the United Nations Human Rights Council, have condemned Australia's offshore detention policy, describing it as a violation of international human rights standards. [HRRC](http://HRRC)
- **Conditions in Detention:** Reports from organisations such as the Asylum Seeker Resource Centre highlight the severe conditions in offshore detention centres, including inadequate healthcare, mental health issues, and limited access to legal assistance.
