

## Offshore Detention:

- Policy Overview: Since August 2012, Australia has implemented a policy of
  offshore processing for individuals who arrive by boat seeking asylum. This policy
  involves transferring asylum seekers to detention centres located in Nauru and
  Manus Island, Papua New Guinea. refugeecouncil.org.au
- Legal Framework: In July 2013, the Australian Government established a policy stating that individuals arriving by boat seeking asylum would never be resettled in Australia, even if they are recognised as refugees. refugeecouncil.org.au
- Human Rights Concerns: Human rights organisations, including the United Nations Human Rights Council, have condemned Australia's offshore detention policy, describing it as a violation of international human rights standards. <u>HRRC</u>
- Conditions in Detention: Reports from organisations such as the Asylum Seeker Resource Centre highlight the severe conditions in offshore detention centres, including inadequate healthcare, mental health issues, and limited access to legal assistance. <u>Asylum Seeker Resource Centre</u>
